Why fundraise for HorseWorld?

Over 100 rescued horses, ponies, and donkeys live at HorseWorld, all in various stages of rehabilitation.

Many of the animals at HorseWorld have come from backgrounds of neglect, abuse, and unimaginable cruelty. The emotional scars of their ordeal can take years to heal, some never forget.

We aim to heal the physical and emotional wounds and empower our horses to move forward with their lives, setting them up for a brighter future.

Many will need long-term specialist care for the rest of their lives. We have horses who can't eat grass, others have allergies, skin conditions, respiratory conditions, arthritis, the list goes on and on. Some will find homes on our loan scheme eventually, but others will remain at HorseWorld for the rest of their lives.

Once a horse is rescued by HorseWorld, we guarantee to do the best for them for the rest of their lives, no matter what problems they have.

This is where you come in..... we need your help to give these horses, ponies and donkeys the love and care they deserve.

By fundraising for HorseWorld, you will be helping to change the lives of horses who could otherwise have faced a very bleak future.

Be Prepared: Fundraising Guidelines

- If you are planning a large event with lots of people, you must complete a health and safety risk assessment. For more information about this, please visit [hse.gov.uk/event-safety](https://www.hse.gov.uk/event-safety).
- For events involving the public, you'll need Public Liability Insurance. The venue you're using may already have this, so it's always worth checking.
- If you are serving food, make sure you're up to date with the current food hygiene regulations by visiting [food.gov.uk](https://www.food.gov.uk).
- If your event is open to the public, make sure that you have access to a first aid kit and that a trained first aider is available for any emergencies.
- You may need to arrange a Temporary Events Notice if you plan to sell/serve alcohol, provide entertainment such as music, dancing or indoor sporting events or if you want to serve hot food or drink between 11pm and 5am. Visit [gov.uk/temporary-events-notice](https://www.gov.uk/temporary-events-notice) for further information.
- If you're under 18, you'll need permission from a parent or guardian to fundraise.
- It is important to state that you are raising money "in support of HorseWorld Trust". Make sure you include this, along with our registered charity number 1121920 on any promotional material.
- If you are using a venue for your event, make sure they have the correct licenses for serving food/drink and entertaining.
- If you're going to hold a raffle or lottery, please read the latest regulations from the Gambling Commission before doing so. you can view these at [gamblingcommission.gov.uk](https://www.gamblingcommission.gov.uk).
- To do a street collection, you need a licence from your local council. Please contact us for more information about how to obtain this. - Running an event in support of HorseWorld Trust means it's your responsibility to make sure it is safe and legal. HorseWorld Trust cannot accept any liability.
