What is Discovery?



HorseWorld's Discovery Courses bring rescued, rehabilitated horses together with young people who are typically outside of mainstream education or find it difficult to learn in a formal school setting.

Those who are referred to Discovery can have complex needs ranging from special educational needs and requirements to problems surrounding emotional wellbeing and behavioural challenges.

Working alongside rescued horses in an outdoor environment gives the young people an opportunity to excel in a way they have been unable to do in a structured school setting, developing their confidence, communication skills and self-esteem.

The Discovery horses have all come from rescued backgrounds and were facing very uncertain futures before arriving at HorseWorld. Many were neglected or abandoned and didn't receive the love and attention they deserve. These horses show a great appreciation of their new lives in the centre of the young people's attention.

Wouldn't it be incredible if Discovery can help even more young people and more rescued horses to have a future with clear direction and focus, a positive purpose in life!

Be Prepared: Fundraising Guidelines

- If you are planning a large event with lots of people, you must complete a health and safety risk
 assessment. For more information about this, please visit hse gov.uk/event-safety.
- For events involving the public, you'll need Public Liability Insurance. The venue you're using may already have this, so it's always worth checking.
- If you are serving food, make sure you're up to date with the current food hygiene regulations by visiting food.gov.uk.
- If your event is open to the public, make sure that you have access to a first aid kit and that a trained first aider is available for any emergencies.
- You may need to arrange a Temporary Events Notice if you plan to sell/serve alcohol, provide
 entertainment such as music, dancing or indoor sporting events or if you want to serve hot food or
 drink between 11pm and 5am. Visit gov.uk/temporary-events-notice for further information.
- If you're under 18, you'll need permission from a parent or guardian to fundraise.
- It is important to state that you are raising money "in support of HorseWorld Trust". Make sure you
 include this, along with our registered charity number 1121920 on any promotional material.
- If you are using a venue for your event, make sure they have the correct licenses for serving food/drink and entertaining.
- If you're going to hold a raffle or lottery, please read the latest regulations from the Gambling Commission before doing so, you can view these at gamblingcommission.gov.uk.
- To do a street collection, you need a licence from your local council. Please contact us for more
 information about how to obtain this. Running an event in support of HorseWorld Trust means it's
 your responsibility to make sure it is safe and legal. HorseWorld Trust cannot accept any liability.
